In accordance with art. 13 section 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Official Journal EU L 119 of 4 May 2016, p. 1) (hereinafter: GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Tadeusz Manteuffel Institute of History of Polish Academy of Sciences (hereinafter: IH PAN) seated in Warsaw, at 29/31 Rynek Starego Miasta;

3. Your personal data shall be processed for the online transmission of the workshop “Current Themes and Methods in Intellectual History” organized by the IH PAN;
4. Your personal data shall be processed throughout the entire period of the implementation of the activities for the scientific, educational and promotional purposes of the Polish Academy of Sciences, and after the completion of the abovementioned activities they shall be stored for the mandatory archiving of the documentation for a period of time specified in separate regulations;
5. With regard to your personal data, decisions shall not be taken in an automated manner;
6. You have the right to access your personal data, to rectify your personal data, to request the administrator to limit the processing of your personal data, with the reservation of the cases referred to in art. 18 clause 2 of the GDPR, as well as to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR;
7. You do not have the right to delete your personal data, to transfer your personal data or the right to object to the processing of your personal data since the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 clause 1 the GDPR.

Providing your personal data in the application and consent to their processing is voluntary, and in case of refusal it will not be possible to attend the abovementioned conference.
