Regulations for NAWA STER International Fellowships within NEXT GENERATION GLOBAL PhDs Project

§ 1

General Information

1. The STER Program is one of NAWA’s flagship programs supporting the systematic internationalisation of Polish HEIs and scientific institutions.
2. The project “Next Generation Global PhDs,” funded by NAWA STER, is the first attempt to internationalize the Anthropos Doctoral School by establishing a long-term cooperation between the School and institutions abroad, and increasing international mobility of doctoral students.

§ 2

Detailed Information

1. The Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange (NAWA) granted the Tadeusz Manteuffel Institute of History at the Polish Academy of Sciences (further: IH PAN) and the Anthropos Doctoral School at PAN (further: SD Anthropos) in the amount of 1 236 553,20 PLN in order for it to carry out “Next Generation Global PhDs Project” as part of the STER Program, between 3 January 2022 and 31 December 2024.

3. Dr Olga Linkiewicz, director of SD Anthropos, is responsible for carrying out and coordinating the Project (further: Project Leader).
4. Part 4 of the Project planned for the distribution of 11 international fellowships.
5. Doctoral students of SD Anthropos will be able to participate in the fellowship programme after having their individual research plan approved.
6. Participants will be selected on the basis of a competition after a call is announced.
7. Living costs will be covered for fellowship recipients (12,000 PLN/month in OECD countries and 8000 PLN/month outside the OECD) as well as travel costs in keeping with the IH PAN regulations from 7 August 2017, IH PAN Directive nr. 1/2017.
8. Fellowship trips abroad can only take place during the time period specified in the announcement. Fellowships last between 30 and 90 days.

§ 3

Requirements

1. Fellowship announcement will be published on the SD Anthropos website.
2. The Fellowship Committee, convened for the period of the Project, will assess the application documents.
3. The Fellowship Committee will be convened by the Project Leader.
4. The names of members of the Selection Committee are public and provided freely.
5. The Committee – composed of at least four members – is headed by the Project leader.

6. The fellowship assessment decisions shall be carried out respecting the principles of equal treatment. Applicants to the programme will not be discriminated against on grounds of sex, age, disability, ethnic origin and race, religion, belief and sexual orientation.
7. Application documents include:
 - a) application form including consent for data processing according to the provided template,
 - b) academic CV,
 - c) written confirmation (e-mail) from a prospective host institution who tentatively agrees to take on the role,
 - d) a work schedule covering all the planned activities with a justification for undertaking them and the expected results,
 - e) dissertation supervisor’s recommendation.
8. Candidates are obliged to submit a complete set of application documents at the place and time indicated in the call for applications. Incomplete application documents or documents submitted after the deadline will not be considered.
9. The Selection Committee will assess and rank applications according to the following criteria:

Assessment of the accomplishments of the doctoral student	0–5
Assessment of the host institution	0–5
Assessment of the work schedule	0–10
Total points:	0–20

10. The results of the recruitment process in the form of an alphabetical list of participants accepted for the Program are made public by the Project Leader and the chairperson of the Selection Committee.

§4

Obligations of the Fellowship Recipients

1. Fellowship recipients are obliged before departing to sign an agreement with IH PAN in order to carry out a scholarship exchange within the STER programme and transferring funds to cover the costs.
2. Fellowship recipients are obliged during or after the trip to send at least one short report with photographic material in order to post information about the trip on the SD Anthropos website and Facebook.
3. It is the Fellowship participant's responsibility within 7 days after the trip to:
 - a) submit a relevant certificate,
 - b) sign the financial statement of the trip.
